Packing List



A simple packing guide to get you prepared for your upcoming trip.

Do you think you can pack for a week in a carry on? Bringing a carry on makes getting in and out of the airport a whole lot easier, you never have to worry about losing your luggage, and you also just have less stuff to pack and repack while you're away. Let's see how creative you can get and try bringing simple pieces that you can mix and match through out the week.

THE DRESS CODE

There is no formal dress code in Croatia. The weather this time of year is sunny, warm, yet can get windy, which could lead to a little chill in the mornings and evenings. We'll spend lots of time at the beach and exploring Dubrovnik and the near by regions. Plan to feel cozy at our villa like a home away from home. There is a pool to relax and unwind, and the nearby town offers a small bodega, and a few casual restaurants on the water where you can grab food during free time.

What to bring (all options to help you pack):

- Comfortable walking shoes
- Sandals for the boat/beach
- 2 pair of socks
- 2 bathing suites
- 2 beach cover ups
- Athletic shorts + tank
- Sweater/sweatshirt
- Lounge pants to hang out in
- Light weight long sleeve
- Sleeping wear
- A nice outfit for our meals out on Sunday, Monday, & Wednesday
- A comfortable yet nice outfit for the optional wine tour on Thursday

Yoga

We have an optional yoga class everyday, I encourage you to reuse what you bring!

- 2-3 leggings
- 2-3 sports bras
- 2-3 tanks

Use your clothes listed above to layer up before and after class

Yes, you will need to bring a yoga mat if you choose to practice! You can purchase a foldable, travel mat that can lay right on top of your clothes in your carry on.

Other basic things:

- Sunscreen
- Your sunnies
- Bug Spray
- A converter to charge your cell phone (a European converter works)
- Your personal toiletries/makeup
- Shampoo/Conditioner, Soap + Face Wash

Do I take out cash before I go?

It is not necessary. The only cash you will need will be for purchasing souvenirs and I suggest going to the ATM that is in Zaton Bay proper.

Water

The tap water is safe to drink so you can bring a water bottle with you to eliminate plastic waste.

Laundry Available

There is a washing machine in our villa! Consider washing your clothes half way through the week so you can reuse what you packed.
